

Join us for **nine nights and eight full days** as we enjoy Guatemala's colonial town of Antigua and the beautiful Lake Atitlán region. Limited to 10 tourists.



TOUR DATES: July 2 – 11, 2025

- **Wednesday** – Travel/Arrival day – we will transport you from the airport in Guatemala City to the hotel in Antigua where we will spend four nights – our **welcome dinner** is the only official tour event this day
- **Thursday – Saturday** are full days in Antigua visiting artists' studios, crafts workshops, museums, markets, and colonial ruins. There is an add-on option for a cooking class.
- **Sunday** – travel day from Antigua to Panajachel on Lake Atitlán where we will spend four nights. On the way we will stop in Chichicastenango for their famous Sunday market.
- **Monday – Wednesday** are full days on Lake Atitlán where we will travel by boat around the lake visiting the many towns including San Juan La Laguna, Santiago Atitlán, and San Pedro la Laguna
- **Thursday** – we'll explore Panajachel this morning before taking our van back to Guatemala City and our **celebration dinner**
- **Friday** – Travel/Departure day – there are no scheduled activities this day

TOUR PRICE INCLUDES:

- **Transportation** from the airport in Guatemala (GUA) to the hotel on the arrival day.
- **Accommodations** for one person in a double occupancy room (unless single occupancy upgrade is chosen)
- **Two meals** including a **welcome dinner** and a **celebration dinner** (guests are responsible for all other meals).
- **Transportation** between Antigua, Chichicastenango, Lake Atitlán, and Guatemala City
- **Transportation** to and **entrance fees** for all scheduled excursions.
- **Transportation** from the hotel to the airport in Guatemala (GUA) for return flight anytime on departure day.



TOUR PRICE & DEADLINES

- **Double occupancy** cost is \$2,650.00 per person
Single occupancy add \$950.00
- A \$500.00 per person **deposit** is required to reserve a space (non-refundable unless the tour doesn't "make" with a minimum of 5 people by **March 2, 2025**)
- Tour **closes May 7, 2025**
- Remaining **full payment** is due by **May 26, 2025**



OTHER NOTES:

- Price does not include airfare to and from Guatemala (GUA). Guests are responsible for their own travel arrangements to ensure arrival and departure to and from the airport on designated days. We are available to consult while guests make these arrangements.
- The departure day of the **Guatemala Antigua & Lake Atitlán** tour adjoins the arrival date of the **Guatemala Tikal** tour (25-07-12-GT-TIK), making it easy to combine the two trips. If you join both tours, you receive an extra night of accommodations in Guatemala at no additional cost. The rate for the **two tours together** (15 nights total) is: \$4,500 double occ (single occ add \$1,550)
- We recommend all tourists consider purchasing their own **travel and health insurance** and consult with their medical professional regarding any **recommended vaccinations and health precautions**.

~ IDENTIFICATION ~

A valid passport is required.

~ ALTITUDE ~

~ WEATHER ~

Because both Antigua and Lake Atitlán are in the mountains, their weather and temperatures are moderate year round. Typical July daytime temperatures are in the lower 80s, nights in the low 60s.

~ TRANSPORTATION ~

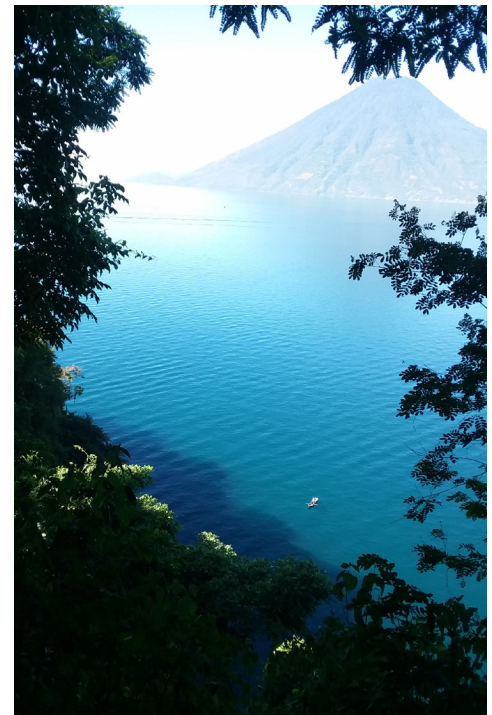
We use various modes of transportation in Guatemala, including Tuk-Tuk taxis on cobblestone streets, 20-person boats, and vans for longer drives between towns.

~ PHYSICAL EXERTION ~ low high

This tour requires some physical agility to be able to get in and out of the small taxi boats as they bob up and down in the waves. It also requires some stamina to walk at a leisurely pace on hilly cobblestone streets for 15 to 20 minutes at a time. There are opportunities for more strenuous hikes, mountain climbing experiences, and swimming for those interested.

~ MEDICAL FACILITIES ~

During most of the tour, major medical facilities will be more than two hours away.



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
