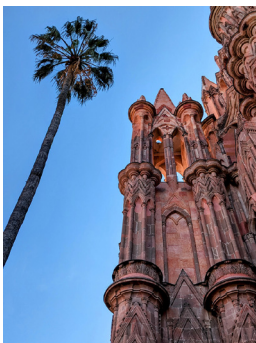

**Tour Dates:** October 28 – November 4, 2025

- **Tuesday** – Travel/Arrival day – the only scheduled event this day is our **welcome dinner**.
- **Wednesday – Monday** are full days including the following:
  - Art-focused stops including the art complex *Fabrica La Aurora*, the showroom of world renowned folk art collectors Mayer Shacter & Susan Page, and many other art galleries and local artist studios.
  - Cultural stops, including visits to the *Jardin*, the *Paroquia de San Miguel*, local markets, *Casa de Cultura*
  - Exploration of local *Day of the Dead* traditions, including a participatory visit to a local cemetery and viewings of ofrendas throughout town.
  - Choice to participate in or watch the *Dia de los Muertos parade*.
  - A trip to the UNESCO world heritage site of *Atotonilco* where we will visit the charming church.
  - Day trip to the town of *Dolores Hidalgo*, known for its ceramics, including an alfresco lunch and a visit to the *Parroquia de Nuestra Señora de los Dolores*.
  - Half day vineyard tour and wine tasting/pairing
- **Tuesday** – Travel/Departure day – no official tour events are scheduled for this day.

### TOUR PRICE INCLUDES

- **Transportation** from the airport in Querétaro Mexico (QRO) to the hotel on the arrival day.
- **Accommodations for 7 nights** for one person in a double occupancy room at a charming boutique hotel (unless single occupancy upgrade is chosen)
- **Three meals** including a **welcome dinner** (guests are responsible for all other meals).
- **Transportation** to and **entrance fees** for all scheduled excursions.
- **Transportation** from the hotel to the Querétaro airport (QRO) anytime on the departure day.



## TOUR PRICE & DEADLINES

- **Double occupancy** cost is \$2,350.00 per person; **single occupancy** add \$800.00
- A \$500.00 per person **deposit** is required to reserve a space (non-refundable unless the tour doesn't "make" with a **minimum of 6 people by June 20, 2025**)
- The tour **closes on August 25, 2025**
- Remaining **full payment** is due by **September 23, 2025**

## Other Notes:

- Price does not include airfare to and from Querétaro (QRO). Guests are responsible for their own travel arrangements to ensure arrival and departure to and from the airport on designated days. We are available to consult while guests make these arrangements.
- The arrival day of the **San Miguel** tour adjoins the departure day of the **Querétaro** tour (25-10-20-MX-QRO), making it easy to combine the two trips. If you join both tours, you receive an extra night of accommodations in Querétaro at no additional cost. The rate for the **two tours together** (15 nights total) is: \$4,700 double occ (single occ add \$1,600)

### ~ IDENTIFICATION ~

A valid passport is required.

### ~ ALTITUDE ~

San Miguel de Allende: 6,234 ft

### ~ WEATHER ~

Because of its higher altitude, weather and temperatures are moderate year round. Typical daytime temperatures are in the upper 70s and nighttime temperatures around 50f. October and November are traditionally very dry.

### ~ ACCOMMODATIONS ~

We stay at Casa Carly, a wonderfully located charming boutique hotel with an authentic San Miguel feel. Each suite is unique and opens up to an extensive courtyard that makes for a great meeting point and wonderful evening happy hours.
